AN ACT

- Making appropriations from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry 2 and the Department of Community and Economic Development to 3 provide for the expenses of administering the Workers' 4 Compensation Act, The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act and the Office of Small Business Advocate for the fiscal year 5 6 July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, and for the payment of bills 7 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year 8 9 ending June 30, 2023.
- 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. The sum of \$75,802,000, or as much thereof as may
- 13 be necessary, is appropriated from the Workmen's Compensation
- 14 Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry for
- 15 the payment of all salaries, wages and other compensation and
- 16 travel expenses, for contractual services and other expenses
- 17 necessary for the administration of the act of June 2, 1915
- 18 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, and
- 19 the act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.566, No.284), known as The
- 20 Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act, for the fiscal year
- 21 beginning July 1, 2023, and for the payment of bills incurred

- 1 and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June
- 2 30, 2023.
- 3 Section 2. The sum of \$550,000 is appropriated from the
- 4 restricted revenue account within the Workmen's Compensation
- 5 Administration Fund to the Office of Small Business Advocate in
- 6 the Department of Community and Economic Development as provided
- 7 in the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the
- 8 Workers' Compensation Act, for the operation of that office for
- 9 the fiscal year July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023, or
- 11 immediately, whichever is later.
