SUMMARY: This bill would amend Title 75 (Vehicles) providing for special registration plates for veterans of an ally foreign country.

ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 729 would require the Department of Transportation (DOT) to issue special registration plates for individuals who were a citizen of a foreign country that allied with the United States in a military conflict and served in a military branch of that foreign country during the military conflict. The special registration plate would be issued upon application to DOT, accompanied with a \$20.00 fee, which would be in addition to the registration fee. The special registration plate would be used only on passenger cars and trucks with a registered gross weight of no more than 14,000 pounds.

This act would be effective 60 days upon passage.

FISCAL IMPACT: DOT would incur a one-time cost of \$15,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18 for system changes and the creation of the specialized design for the registration plate, defined under this act.
