SUMMARY: House Bill 1048, amends Act 21 of 1951, known as the Liquor Code, for the purpose of providing licenses and regulations for liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages for certain licensees.

ANALYSIS: HB 1048 eliminates the \$700 application surcharge for renewal of liquor licenses by national veterans' organizations or volunteer fire companies. The PLCB estimates between 1,000 and 1,200 national veterans' organizations and volunteer fire companies' licensees.

This bill will become effective 60 days after enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will decrease revenue to the State Stores Fund by approximately \$840,000 annually.
