SUMMARY: HB 1170 establishes the Construction Industry Employee Verification Act.

ANALYSIS: HB 1170 requires that all construction industry employers verify the employment eligibility of new hires through the Federal government's E-Verify system. The Department of Labor and Industry is responsible for receiving and investigating complaints of violations of this act. The department is then required to verify the eligibility of employees through Federal officials. In the case of continued violations of this Act, the department shall refer the employer to the Attorney General.

FISCAL IMPACT: To enforce this act, the department will need to hire eleven additional full timeemployees, in addition to administrative costs broken down in the table below:
