**SUMMARY:** House Bill 471 expands the liquid fuels tax refund to include ready mix concrete vehicles that utilize a power takeoff unit.

**ANALYSIS:** House Bill 471 amends Title 75 to allow individuals to be reimbursed up to 30% of the amount of tax imposed if the individual uses or buys liquid fuels to mix concrete from a vehicle by means of a power takeoff.

This bill requires claims to be filed on a quarterly basis and within 60 days of the end of each quarter. However, no refund can be authorized or paid on a single claim for tax on fewer than 100 gallons of liquid fuels.

HB 471 will take effect 60 days upon enactment.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation believes this expansion would result in a negative fiscal impact to the Motor License Fund. The Department of Revenue estimates a reduction of \$1,000,000 to \$3,000,000 in revenue.
