Dear Acting Secretary Mumin:

This certification for the 2023-24 fiscal year marks the sixteenth year of statewide property tax relief for Pennsylvania homeowners. This year, \$864.4 million will be available for property tax relief, including funding for the enhanced Property Tax/Rent Rebate program.

The Property Tax Relief Fund will transfer funds to the Lottery Fund including \$22.3 million to reimburse costs related to supplemental property tax rebates and \$64.9 million for enhancements to the Property Tax/Rent Rebate program.

In addition, \$27.2 million will be used to reimburse eligible school districts pursuant to Section 324 of the Taxpayer Relief Act. These are known as Sterling Act reimbursements. I also certify that \$750.0 million will be available for statewide property tax relief.

The Department of Education is hereby authorized to provide school districts with property tax reduction allocations under Section 505 of the Taxpayer Relief Act of 2006. The department is authorized to provide school districts \$750.0 million for statewide property tax relief as required by Section 505 of the act and an additional \$27.2 million to reimburse eligible school districts pursuant to Section 324 of the act, commonly referred to as Sterling Act reimbursements. The Department of Education will notify each Pennsylvania school district of its property tax reduction allocation no later than May 1, as the act requires.
