The Commonwealth received \$3,935,169,363.40 through Title V of the CARES Act (originally rounded to \$3,935,170,000.00). Those monies were originally deposited into the federal COVID-Relief Fund account (Account 87710). Act 24 of 2020 specifies that the funds received are restricted and shall be appropriated. The account will now be designated as the COVID-Relief Fund Restricted.

Act 24 of 2020 appropriated various lined items from the account. In accordance with the Act, the line-item appropriations are restricted to the activity authorized and are established as continuing appropriations, not subject to lapse.

Act 17A of 2020 appropriated additional line items from the account. Act 114 of 2020 further specified that all unexpended funds in the accounts are appropriated for transfer to the Department of Corrections. The adjustment herein includes refund posting redistributions in accordance with Act 114 of 2020.
