SUMMARY: This bill amends the Tax Reform Code, in sales and use tax, further providing for definitions.

ANALYSIS: SB 343 amends the definition of farming to exempt from sales and use tax (SUT) Cervidae livestock operations regardless of marketing, as well as the propagation and raising of swine and exotic animals, cervids, game animals, game birds, and other non-domesticated animals for use in controlled hunting.

FISCAL IMPACT: This bill has a fiscal impact of \$1.7 million in FY 2021-22 and \$2.4 million in FY 2022-23 to exempt Cervidae operations from SUT.
