



# SAP Basics Quick Reference Guide

## Log On



- Double-Click the SAP Logon
- Select the appropriate system from the list by clicking on it.
- Click the Log on button (or double-click the system name).

## Log Off



- Double-Click the SAP icon on any screen
- Select the **YES** button to confirm log off

## Sessions

- To open a new session
- To switch between sessions:  
[ALT+TAB] or [CTRL+ESC]
- To close a session  
System > End Session

## Frequently Use Commands

<b>/OXXXX</b>	Creates a session and goes to transaction XXXX
<b>/O</b>	Lists open sessions
<b>/NXXXX</b>	Ends the current session
<b>/NS000</b>	Return to the SAP system screen from any system screen
<b>/NEND</b>	Logs off the system

## Change Report Layout

To change the way a report is sorted, select a column name and select the **Sort ascending** icon or the **Sort descending** icon. Select the **Change layout** icon to open the *Change Layout* pop-up window.

Click on fields in the **Displayed** column and select the **Remove** icon to remove them from the report.

Click on fields in the **Column set** column and select the **Add** icon to add them to the report.

Select the **Transfer** icon to modify the report layout.
