AN ACT

- 1 Making appropriations from the Professional Licensure
- 2 Augmentation Account and from restricted revenue accounts
- within the General Fund to the Department of State for use by
- 4 the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs in
- support of the professional licensure boards assigned
- 6 thereto.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The sum of \$47,278,000, or as much thereof as may
- 10 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Professional
- 11 Licensure Augmentation Account within the General Fund to the
- 12 Department of State for the operation of the Bureau of
- 13 Professional and Occupational Affairs, including the State Board
- 14 of Auctioneer Examiners, for the fiscal year July 1, 2018, to
- 15 June 30, 2019.
- Section 2. (a) The sum of \$8,460,000, or as much thereof as
- 17 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted
- 18 receipts account of the State Board of Medicine for the
- 19 operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2018, to June
- 20 30, 2019.

- 1 (b) The sum of \$2,283,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted receipts
- 3 account of the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine for the
- 4 operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2018, to June
- 5 30, 2019.
- 6 (c) The sum of \$284,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted receipts
- 8 account of the State Board of Podiatry for the operation of the
- 9 board for the fiscal year July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2019.
- 10 (d) The sum of \$647,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Athletic Commission
- 12 Augmentation Account for the State Athletic Commission, as
- 13 authorized by 5 Pa.C.S. § 1512 (relating to Athletic Commission
- 14 Augmentation Account), for the support and operation of the
- 15 commission for the fiscal year July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2019.
- 16 (e) Each appropriation listed in subsections (a), (b), (c)
- 17 and (d) shall not be treated as an augmentation to the
- 18 Department of State, general government appropriation or any
- 19 other appropriation, but shall be treated and accounted for as
- 20 separate appropriations respectively.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018, or
- 22 immediately, whichever is later.
