SUMMARY: This bill would amend Title 75 (Vehicles) providing for a fee exemption for individuals requesting a duplicate registration card through an online transaction.

ANALYSIS: HB 1910 would prohibit the collection of a fee charge for individuals requesting a duplicate registration card ordered at the time of an online transaction where the applicant prints the registration credential.

This bill would not apply to duplicate registration cards processed by the Department of Transportation (DOT) or an agent service of DOT in an over-the-counter transaction or via mail.

This bill would be effective 90 days upon passage.

FISCAL IMPACT: DOT would experience a revenue loss of more than \$343,335, including \$335,000 from the elimination of the fees.
