**SUMMARY:** This bill would amend Title 51 (Military Affairs) and Title 74 (Transportation) designating the Department of Military and Veteran Affairs (DMVA) the liaison of the Civil Air Patrol.

**ANALYSIS:** Senate Bill 137 would designate DMVA the liaison for the Civil Air Patrol requiring DMVA to provide administrative support concerning the receipt and supervision of state fund expenditures appropriated by the General Assembly or secured by the commonwealth for the use and benefit of the Civil Air Patrol. DMVA would also be required to supervise the maintenance and use of commonwealth facilities by the Civil Air Patrol and administer the receipt of requests for assistance by the Civil Air Patrol concerning natural or man-made disasters, including emergency situations. All requested and approved missions must be approved or denied pursuant to Federal procedures, in consultation with the Adjutant General or his or her designee and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency.

Nothing in this act may be construed to limit, diminish or impair an authority, right or agreement validly established and existing on the effective date of this act.

This act would be effective 60 days upon passage.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The Civil Patrol legislative addition was not funded in the Governor's Executive Budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-2018.
