SUMMARY: This bill would amend Title 42 (Judiciary) to add additional judgeships to the Pennsylvania Courts of Common Pleas.

ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 222 would add eight additional judgeships to the Pennsylvania Courts of Common Pleas, including the following:

Judicial District	Number of Judgeships
Seventh – Bucks County	2
Ninth – Cumberland County	1
Twenty-Second – Wayne County	1
Twenty-Seventh – Washington County	1
Thirty-Second – Delaware County	1
Thirty-Eighth – Montgomery County	1
Forty-Third – Monroe County	1
Total	8

These new judgeships would be established on January 2, 2020 and would be filled by the 2019 municipal election.

This act would be effective immediately upon passage.

FISCAL IMPACT: Judiciary would incur a cost of \$1.2 million in Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-20 and an annualized cost of \$2.4 million in FY 2020-21 in personnel costs for the eight additional judgeships established under this act.
