SUMMARY: This bill would amend Title 75 (Vehicles) providing for special registration plates on vehicles or trucks for recipients of Soldier's Medal.

ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 266 would require the Department of Transportation (DOT) to issue special registration plates for recipients of the Soldier's Medal, upon application and a fee of \$20.00, which would be in addition to the registration fee required by DOT. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of no more than 14,000 pounds.

This act would be effective 60 days upon passage.

FISCAL IMPACT: DOT would incur a one-time cost of \$15,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18 for system changes and the creation of a specialized design for the Soldier's Medal registration plate, as defined under this act.
