SUMMARY: This bill would amend Act 151 of 1961 (relating to erection of state highway roadside rests) to require the display of the POW/MIA flag.

ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 625 would require the display of the POW/MIA flag at all roadside rests and welcome centers in the commonwealth.

This act would be effective 60 days upon passage.

FISCAL IMPACT: The Department of Transportation (DOT) would incur a one-time cost of \$470,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18. Currently, DOT Facilities Management Division maintains 35 Roadside Rest Areas and 12 Welcome Centers throughout the commonwealth. This act would require additional flag poles and substructures at each of the 47 locations to accommodate the POW/MIA Flag pursuant to this act.
