**SUMMARY:** This proposal amends the Achieving Better Care by Monitoring All Prescriptions Program (ABC-MAP) Act for the purpose of defining powers and duties of the board, establishing the program and providing for dispenser, pharmacy and first responder requirements, and for access to prescription information.

**ANALYSIS:** House Bill 1005 amends the ABC-MAP Act to include definitions for “first responders” and “opioid overdose agents”. The bill provides additional powers and duties to the ABC-MAP Board with regards to assisting prescribers with identifying those with a history of drug overdoses so as to provide alternative treatment options. This proposal also works to identify additional medications that could assist prescribers in making treatment options for patients who are at risk of a substance use disorder.

This act will take effect in 60 days upon passage.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** HB1005 requires the Department of Health to operate and maintain this opioid overdose administration program daily. It is anticipated that there will be a maximum cost of \$860,000 in the first full year and \$20,000 in the out-years.
