This account is used for the receipt of a portion of employee tax revenues for unemployment compensation (UC). Disbursements from this account are used to maintain and modernize operations of the unemployment compensation system during the implementation and initial deployment of technological upgrades to the delivery system for unemployment compensation payments.
