Act 32 of 2019 amends Chapter 32 of Title 51 (Military Affairs) to create the National Guard Military Family Education Program (MFEP), to provide grants to family members of eligible Pennsylvania National Guard (PANG) members to attend an approved institution of higher learning in Pennsylvania. The following interest-bearing restricted revenue account is being established in the Educational Assistance Program Fund for the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs. All money deposited into the account, including interest, is to be used for the purposes of the program.
