SUMMARY: This bill amends Title 63, in powers and duties, providing for application form for licenses, certificates, registrations and permits.

ANALYSIS: HB 855 requires each licensing board and commission to make paper applications available for individuals who object to submitting an electronic application for either initial licensure or renewal.

FISCAL IMPACT: This bill has an annual fiscal impact of \$381,105 for four clerk typist positions and IT billings to enable all 29 boards and commissions to produce and process paper applications outside of the current online licensure system.
